Spanish WSBK front runner (and Valencia victor) Ruben Xaus has spent his share of time on the tarmac. At Phillip Island's SBK round, Xaus confessed to his former head mechanic Mick Hams that he was losing sleep due to pain from his most recent accident.

Hams is now the team manager for Queensland-based BodiHealth Racing, which is owned by BodiHealth Pty Ltd, who market the BodiHealth TENS device.

This EPRT technology is already being used by at least 30 riders on the Australian and International scene who have sustained painful injuries. At Hams suggestion, Xaus tried the bodihealth device and said it gave him some immediate pain relief. "It helps with my pain, which allows me to focus on my racing."
